- Form a unified voice for city government
- Organize the community for specific goals
- Empower neighbors to identify community needs and pool resource to make positive changes
- Create and preserve neighborhood character and community pride

## **All About Bylaws**

Bylaws serve as the guide on how the association will operate. Bylaws can:

- ▶ **Help resolve problems:** they give members a governing document to refer to when disagreements arise
- **Describe board member positions:** they can also outline the tenure of each position and how, how often, and when elections will be held
- Share membership information: they outline who can be a member and if any dues will be paid by members

## **Community Engagement**

- Newsletters: share a print or electronic newsletter each month
- Social Media: connect members and share news, events, or meetings on Facebook, Instagram or Nextdoor accounts
- **Events and Gatherings:** host regular events and invite the community
