This memorandum addresses the San Antonio Police Department's procedure on the release of audio and video recordings as they relate to two separate critical incidents that occurred on July 21, 2022 and August 4, 2022.

- On July 2, 2022, SAPD officers were dispatched to address a family disturbance 911 call.
- On August 4, 2022, SAPD officers responded to a 911 call for an individual shooting a gun in an apartment complex located at 2914 Roosevelt Avenue.

Consistent with Section 19 of SAPD Procedure 410, the audio and video recordings will not be released because they meet one of the criteria below:

- Critical Incidents where video release is prohibited by law will not be released, for example where the incident involves a juvenile.
- Critical incidents where domestic violence is involved or suspected will not be released unless the Chief of Police determines it serves a law enforcement purpose.
