Operational improvements to improve pedestrian and vehicular safety at Southcross and Pierian.






## Rivas Street District 1 | \$150,000

Reconstruct sidewalks, curbs and driveways on 1200 Block. Potential District 1 Pedestrian Mobility project.




## Mason Street District 2 | \$275,000

Reconstruct sidewalks, curbs and driveways from Willow Street to Spofford Avenue. Potential District 2 Pedestrian Mobility project.




## W. Baetz Boulevard District 3 | \$6 Million

Reconstruct West Baetz Boulevard to include roadway, sidewalks, curbs and driveways from Commercial Avenue to Moursund Avenue.

Pedestrian crossing at Castroville Road between General McMullen Drive and Cupples Road.




# Southcross & Pierian Operational improvements to improve pedestrian District 5 | \$1.6 Million and vehicular safety at Southcross and Pierian.




## Jefferson HS Area District 7 | \$5.4 Million

Improvements include underground conversion, landscaping, lighting and crosswalk enhancements along Wilson Blvd from Club to Donaldson; water fountain restoration, landscaping and irrigation for Thespian island.



## **Monticello Park Streets District 7 | \$8.4 Million**

Reconstruct North Drive from Fredericksburg to Wilson, and Furr Drive from Fredericksburg to Jefferson HS to include curbs, sidewalks, and driveways. Lake Blvd only includes sidewalks along the west side from Club to Woodlawn.
