Pothole Blitz

In April, the Public Works Department kicked off their 10th Annual Pothole Patrol Blitz. The challenge was to encourage residents to locate 10,000 potholes to be fixed in the month of April by calling 311 or reporting through the 311sa app. At the end of the month, Public Works repaired a total of 12,148 potholes citywide, including 2,420 potholes in District 2. That's 20% in the entire city!

Diabetes Insulin Assistance Program

In 2022, Councilman McKee-Rodriguez proposed the Insulin Assistance Program to help families manage the cost of life-saving diabetes medication. After receiving city council approval, the program plan was developed and implemented by the Metro Health Department in association with HEB Pharmacy as a program partner.

In its first year of operation, the program supported ____ individuals with their medication and ____ individuals also participated in the City’s Diabetes Education program.

Following its first year of success, Metro Health and H-E-B relaunched the Diabetes Insulin Assistance Program on May 15, 2026, to help even more families.

Who Is Eligible?

Residents of Bexar County and San Antonio who need financial assistance paying for insulin prescriptions are eligible to participate.

No proof of income, insurance, citizenship, or additional documentation is required to enroll.

As an added benefit, you will be contacted by Metro Health's Diabetes Prevention and Control Program to attend fun, no-cost diabetes workshops. Participation in the workshop is optional and not a requirement for receiving financial prescription assistance.

Families or individuals within San Antonio and Bexar County are eligible for the program. If you or someone you know needs help affording the cost of insulin, here’s how to get connected:

How to Access the Program



Submit Your Insulin Prescription to a participating pharmacy through your medical provider or fill it in person.



Ask the H-E-B Pharmacy representative about the Diabetes Insulin Assistance Program to get connected.



Complete the Consent Form to receive up to \$100 towards the cost of your prescription.



San Antonio Chapter of the Tuskegee Airmen, Inc.

Tuskegee Memorial Way

Our District 2 City Council office collaborated with the San Antonio Chapter of the Tuskegee Airmen, Inc. to designate parts of Iowa Street on San Antonio’s eastside as Tuskegee Airmen memorial way.

The Tuskegee Airmen were the country’s first Black pilots and support personnel trained during World War II at the Tuskegee Army Airfield in Alabama. The goal is to educate families across San Antonio, and specifically in the Denver Heights neighborhood, where some of the original Airmen resided for many years.

In all, twenty Tuskegee Airmen were documented to have lived in the San Antonio area, with two individuals living near Iowa Street: Mr. Thomas Ellis (Gorman Street) and Mr. Warren Eusan (Cuney Way). The Tuskegee Airmen became known for their bravery and were highly decorated, earning numerous Distinguished Flying Crosses and even Distinguished unit distinctions, executing

important missions and demonstrating steadiness and aviation excellence. As you travel along Iowa street, near Pittman Sullivan park, check out the new memorial designation signs and know they honor the courage and trailblazing leadership of the first black pilots here in San Antonio and across the country.

D2 Pet Care Connect

The City of San Antonio Animal Care Service Department (ACS) and District 2 are leading the way to a safer and more humane environment for residents and animals by focusing on reducing financial and structural barriers to responsible pet ownership.

Some District 2 specific investments we have made recently include the **Eastside Spay-Neuter Hub (providing 6500 additional surgeries every year)** and the **Pet Deposit Assistance Program (providing pet deposit support and education for tenants that choose to adopt at our ACS Shelter).**

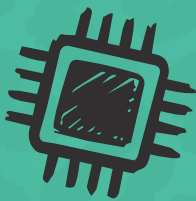


In addition, Councilman McKee-Rodriguez recently joined Animal Care Services to provide direct resources to D2 pet owners through the ACS Pet Care Connect program.

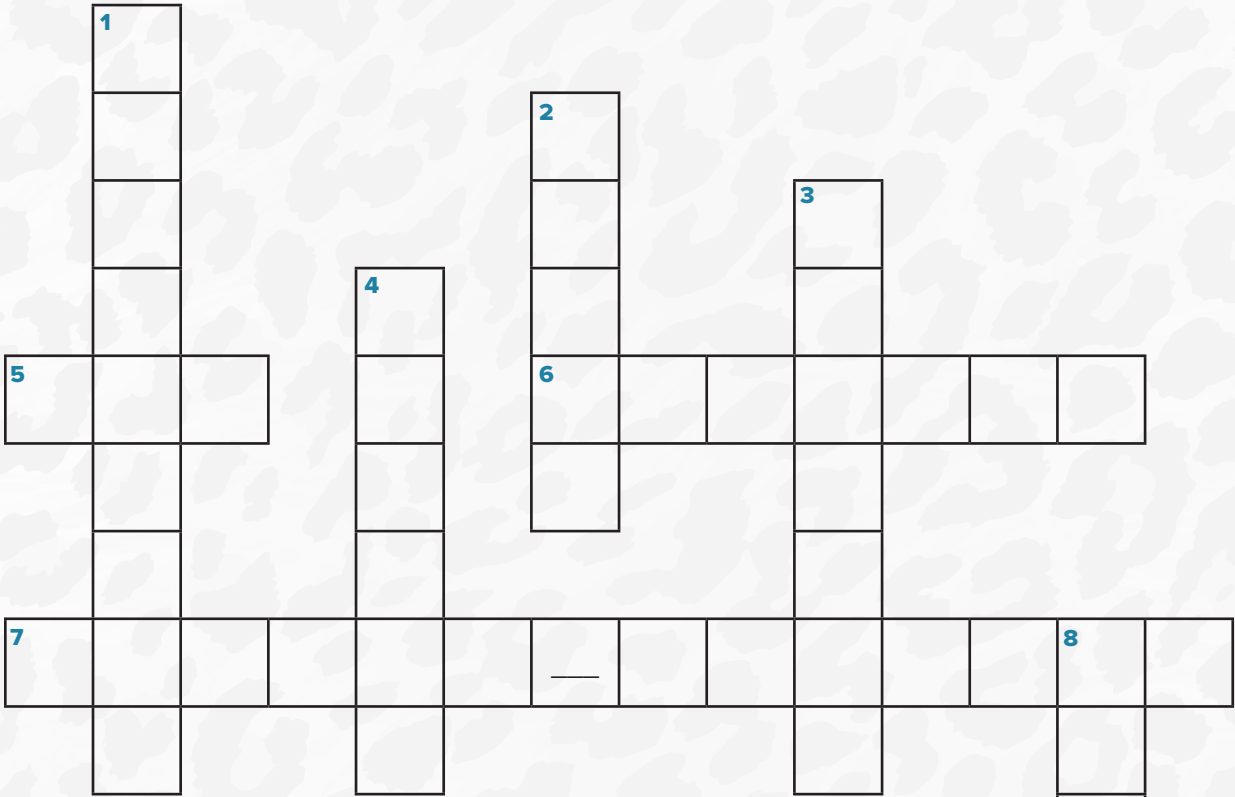

Playground Shades

In August of 2023, the City of San Antonio announced a 5-year plan to place shade structures at all City park playgrounds? Shade structures reduce ambient temperatures by 15 to 20 degrees while allowing children and parents to enjoy longer playtimes and to access the park year-round.

In March 2026, Parks and Recreation announced the installation of two playground shade projects in District 2. One will be located at Lockwood-Dignowity Park which is expected to be completed early in the summer and the second one shade structure has been installed at MLK Park.
