

## **Permit Extension and Permit Completion Request Form**

All permits and any construction documents (except trade permits) issued by the Development Services Department (DSD) belong to the owner of the property, and are not the property of an architect, engineer, contractor or any other party submitting the application for permit or paying the fees. These persons may be an authorized agent of the owner and may apply for an extension if they are listed as contacts on the city permitting system. An owner may request in writing that another architect, engineer, or contractor be added as a contact to a permit to allow that person to act as an agent and to extend the permit.

Trade permits (mechanical, electrical, plumbing, fire alarm, and fire sprinkler permits) are the property of the master of record holding the trade license. A trade permit must be extended by the original trade contractor under whose master license the original trade permit was pulled. If a new contractor is hired to complete the work of a former trade contractor, the new contractor is required to obtain a "completion" permit.

Residential building permits are owned by either a homeowner or a licensed home builder; depending on who owns the lot when the application is submitted (a home builder if closing has not occurred). A homeowner will apply for a Permit Extension. A Home Builder will apply for a Trade Completion permit.

Remaining Permit Work:	
<u>Permit Extension Fee</u> - The fee to extend any permit will be assessed at 50% of the original understand that this fee must be paid if the extension is granted prior to commencing/recomm	
Residential Permit Completion Fee - The fee to complete a trade permit is based on the amount of work that was already completed. Amount of work remaining on a previous trade permit can be estimated at 100%, 75%, 50% and 25%. The fee to issue a completion permit will be based on one of the percentages listed above times the original trade permit fee. If 75% of the work has been completed, the completion permit will be issued with a fee set at the original trade permit fee times 0.25 (25%).
