Memorandum of Intent – Water and Wastewater

WHEREAS, San Antonio and Ein-Netafim both have recognized the importance of water management to the well being and economies of their regions; and

WHEREAS, the industry sectors in both regions have common challenges and a desire to facilitate collaboration for mutual benefit; and

WHEREAS, both the San Antonio Water System and Ein-Netafim agree to work together over the next two years, subject to an understanding to be reached by the parties periodically, to:

- Share expertise and innovative ideas related to operating water reuse systems
- Share expertise and innovative ideas related to efficient operations of wastewater systems inter alia with an emphasis on protection of environmental values
- Share expertise and ideas related to efficient operations of water systems, including design and operations of desalination plants and water conservation
- Foster the development of collaborative projects, programs and research and educational exchanges for the benefit of both water agencies


