Confirmation of Agreement on the Establishment of Friendship City Relationship

between

City of San Antonio, Texas, USA


and


City of Windhoek, Namibia

Based on the Joint Communiqué on the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between the United States of America and Namibia, in order to further consolidate and develop mutual friendly cooperation, and to strengthen the understanding and friendship between the peoples of the two countries, the City of San Antonio, U.S.A. and the City of Windhoek, Namibia have reached agreement concerning the establishment of friendship city relations between the two cities through friendly consultation as following:

1. Both parties agree to further strengthen friendly exchanges, expand cooperation, promote friendship between the peoples of both cities, and carry out various friendly activities.
2. Both parties will make joint efforts to promote economic cooperation and bilateral trade, enhance bilateral exchange and cooperation in the fields of Renewable Energy, Health Services and Environmental Management (Biotechnology), Social Affairs (Community Services), Culture, Tourism, Training and Development, among others.
3. It is decided by both parties that the International Relations Office of San Antonio and the External Relations Office of Windhoek will conduct concrete liaisons, arrangement and implementation of the friendly exchange and cooperation programs between the two cities on behalf of its respective municipal government.
4. As for the matters that were not mentioned in the Agreement, the two municipal governments will decide upon them through friendly negotiation under the conductions of mutual understanding and friendship.

The Agreement is signed in two original copies in English, and both copies are equally authentic and will be valid upon the signing by representative of each party.
