

FAA Runway Incursion Prevention through Situational Awareness (RIPSA). SAT is 1st & only airport working with the FAA to pilot this program.


Surface Movement





Customer Experience Initiatives

Expedited Access for Military Members

Dedicated screening lanes, or front-of-line privileges, designed to minimize wait times and improve convenience for uniformed service members



SAT Pass

Program allows limited number of non-ticketed visitors an opportunity to meet and greet a guest post-security at the airport



SAT Altitude Inclusion Program

Designed to assist individuals with disabilities and their families remove the barriers to travel through a hands-on simulated airport experience from check-in to boarding the aircraft
