




TWO-WAY SHARED-USE PATH TWO-WAY STOP CONTROLLED INTERSECTION CROSSING

TWO-WAY CYCLE TRACK AND SHARED-USE PATH AT COMMERCIAL DRIVEWAY WITH WIDTHS GREATER THAN 34 FT

- 1. FOR CROSSWALK DETAILS REFER TO TYPICAL CROSSWALK DETAILS STANDARD.
- 2. MAINTAIN SEPARATION BETWEEN CURB AND EDGE OF SHARED-USE-PATH OR SIDEWALK AS NEEDED FOR CLEAR ZONE & ROADSIDE SIGNAGE.
- 3. CONCRETE SHARED-USE PATH PAVEMENT MARKINGS SHALL BE HIGH CONTRAST.
- 4. CYCLE TRACKS SHALL INCLUDE 6" SOLID WHITE ARROW AND HELMETED BICYCLE SYMBOL.
