



Farmers Market Permits

HOW TO GET THE PERMITS

- Come to 1901 S. Alamo
- Bring all pertinent information with you:
 - o Market name and location along with days the market will operate
 - o Food source information, if applicable
 - o State Manufacturing License, if applicable
 - Valid Identification

FARMERS MARKET ON-SITE PREPARATION PERMIT

- \$99.91 Annual On-Site Preparation Permit fee
- Valid Only at Farmers Market
- All foods and/or beverages must be prepared on-site at the Farmers Market
- At least one person in booth must have a Food Manager or Food Handler Certification
- Must follow all temporary food guidelines

FARMERS MARKET/FLEA MARKET/TRADE SHOW PERMIT

- \$77.25 Annual Permit fee (Prepackaged goods only)
- Valid at Farmers Markets, Flea Market, or Trade Show
- All goods must be prepackaged with appropriate labels
- Vendors are allowed to provide Bite Size Portions of product if all temporary food guidelines are followed and samples must be thrown away after 4 hours
- If Eggs are sold:
 - o Labeled with farmers/producers name and address and as "ungraded"
 - o Must have label: SAFE HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS: To prevent illness from bacteria, keep eggs refrigerated, cook eggs until yolks are firm, and cook foods containing eggs thoroughly
 - o Kept at 45°F or less
