Details of Service Provided

Employment

- Finding equal opportunities for employment can be difficult after reentry. We partner with community organizations and second chance employers to increase your employment potential that can provide a livable wage.

Housing

- Securing stable housing can be an overwhelming journey. We assist in this process with help from partnerships from community organizations, shelters, and government housing authorities.

Family Support

- Family reunification can be an important piece of a successful reentry. We provide the guidance needed to connect you to family resources and classes.

Spiritual Support

- Faith based groups can offer various systems of support after reentry. We can connect you to these faith and interfaith organizations based on your need.

Government Documents and Legal Aid

- Many resources necessary for a successful reentry require government documents. We assist in the process of recovery by connecting you to agencies that specialize in assisting individuals with securing the proper documentation.

Education & Training

- Continuing education and job-based training are essential in increasing employment opportunities. We partner with community organizations and schools to provide the path to increasing your access to these important steps.

Medical and Health Care

- Continuing your care plan is important to stay healthy after release. We have the tools necessary to connect you with resources that provide you with access to care.

Mental Health and/or Substance Use or Abuse

- Treating mental health or substance use or abuse disorders is important to have a successful reentry, but often overlooked. We partner with a variety of rehabilitation centers and agencies to get you connected to the appropriate service.
